Terms and Conditions

1. Fees is paid in a **maximum of 3 (three) monthly installments** as per amounts specified in the schedule above.
2. Pupils can only be admitted after paying the first installment in full and receiving a clearance note.
3. Pupils who pay less than the installment amount may be turned away on deadline dates.
4. The school accepts payment plans before the beginning of the term and these must be in writing.
5. Payment plans outside the stipulated payment plan above are **ONLY** accepted at the discretion of the Finance Committee which must also respond in writing.
6. All dues (tuition, levies and other obligations) must however be paid in by the last deadline of the term.
7. All practical subjects attract **an extra fee of \$25 and \$35** for 'O' Level and 'A' Level respectively.

TRANSPORT

1. Transport will be paid for separately from school fees and is charged according to distance from the school.
2. Students in boarding go home only at half term break.
3. Parents can visit students in boarding once a term on a designated date.
4. For details and amounts payable to and from your specific destination, call the admin office.
5. Transport payments are made to the school account and pupils must provide proof of payment 72 hours before scheduled term dates.



STATIONERY

1. The school provides textbooks and parents provide all writing materials.
2. All exercise books and counter books are to be brought to the school on the very first day of each New Year or upon enrollment.
3. These must be covered in both khaki cover and then with thick plastic cover after labelling as per teacher's instructions.
4. Labels can be typed or written with a stencil – students do their own labelling
5. Form 1-3 pupils are not allowed phones in the school
FORM 4- 6 students are allowed laptops, phones and tablets for learning purposes only.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT

1. The school will only provide balls for all ball games.
2. In Term 1 pupils must bring a tennis racket and boys must also bring cricket bats.
3. In Term 2 All Pupils bring hockey equipment and soccer boots.
4. Pupils who are selected into teams will be requested to purchase team tracksuits separately.
5. Team kits will be provided by the school

BRANDED UNIFORMS

1. These are supplied only at the school.
2. All uniform items must be labelled using embroidery
3. Parents are not allowed to tailor-make uniforms.
4. Any branded uniform bought elsewhere will be confiscated.
5. Uniforms are paid for in advance and do not have an option of installments.
6. Pupils are automatically billed for the purchase of main uniforms in Term 1 (Winter pack, Summer Pack and Blazer) in Forms 1 and 3 to uphold the standard of uniforms.
